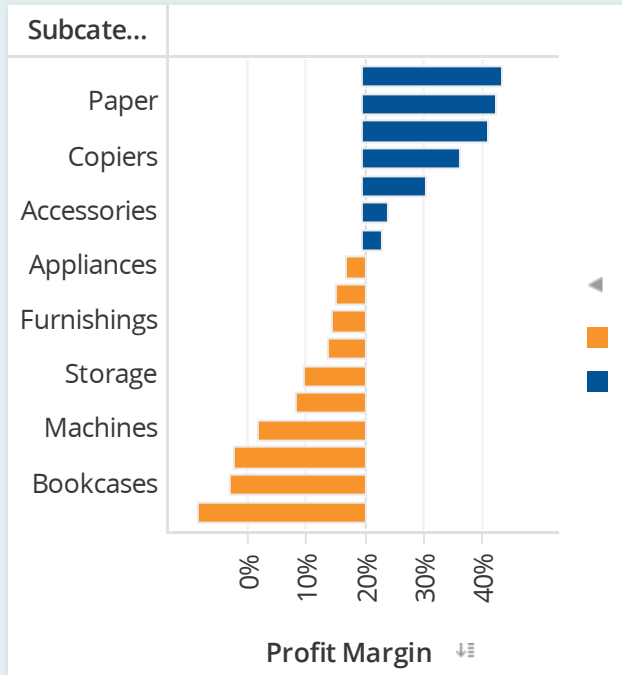


DEVIATION

Use to explore how the observed value of a metric differs from a fixed value, which can be zero or another constant number.

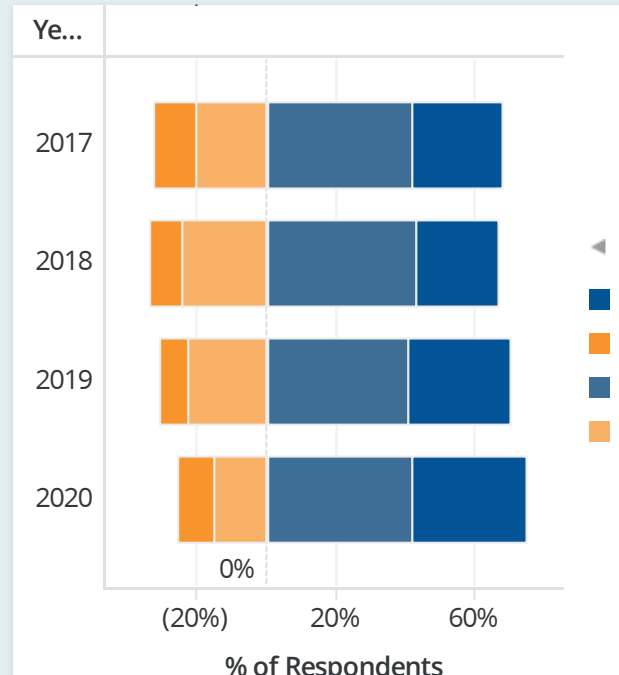
Diverging Bar Chart (Horizontal)

Horizontal bar chart that displays how a metric value deviates from a set value of interest, such as an average or a goal.



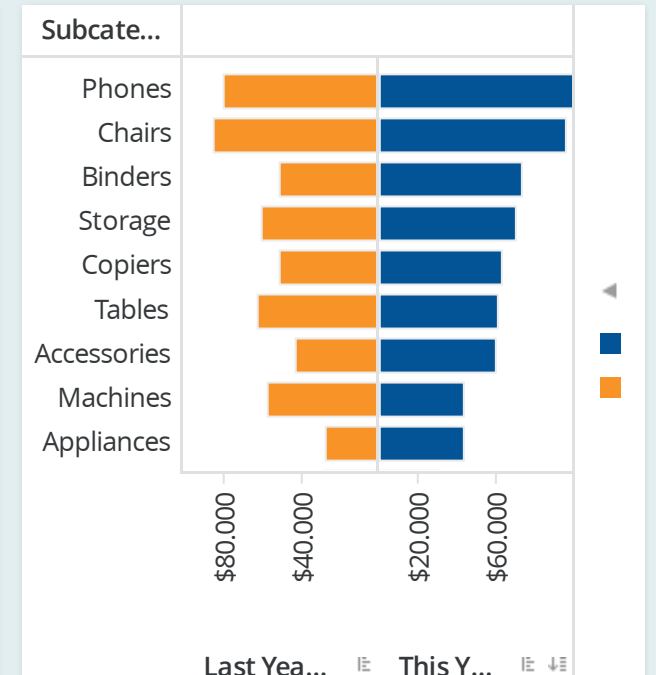
Diverging Stacked Bar Chart

Horizontal stacked bar chart commonly used to showcase survey results. Positive and negative responses are stacked to the right and left of the



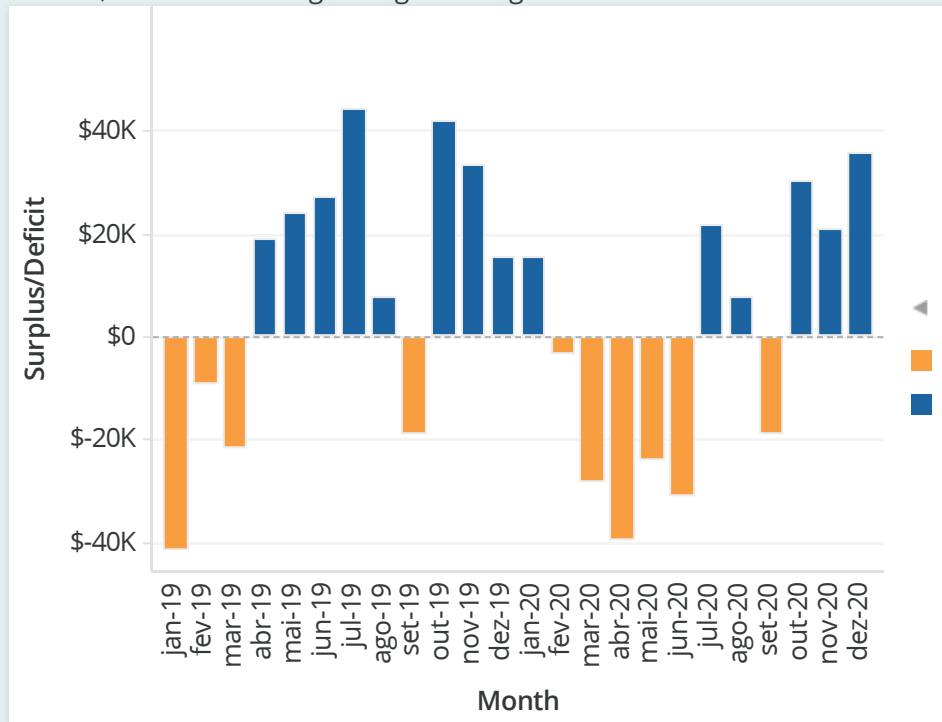
Tornado (Butterfly) Chart

Horizontal bar chart that is sorted from largest to smallest and compares two metrics using the same axis scale.



Diverging Bar Chart (Vertical)

Vertical bar chart that displays how a metric value deviates from a set value of interest, such as an average or a goal. Using a time attribute is recommended.



Stacked Area Chart

Uses the stacked area within a line chart to show the value of a metric over time.
