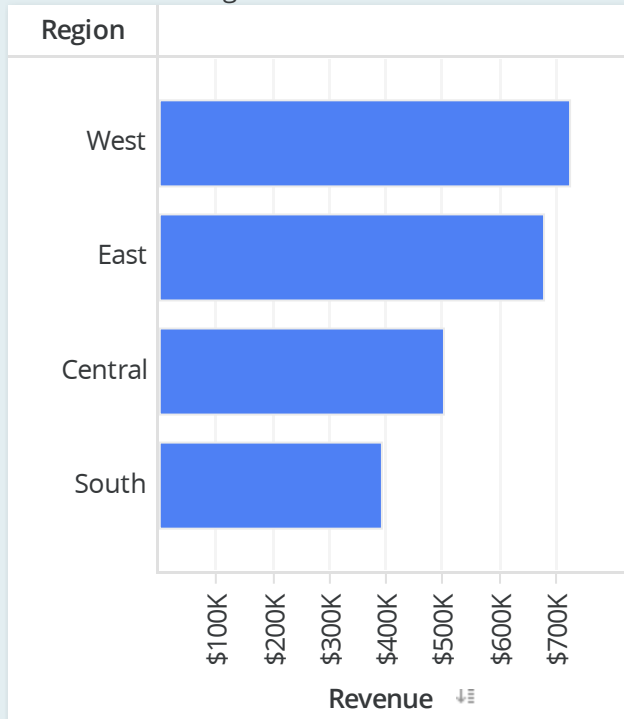


RANKING

Use to show how categories are ordered by data values.

Horizontal Bar Chart

Uses the length of horizontal bars to compare data values across categories.



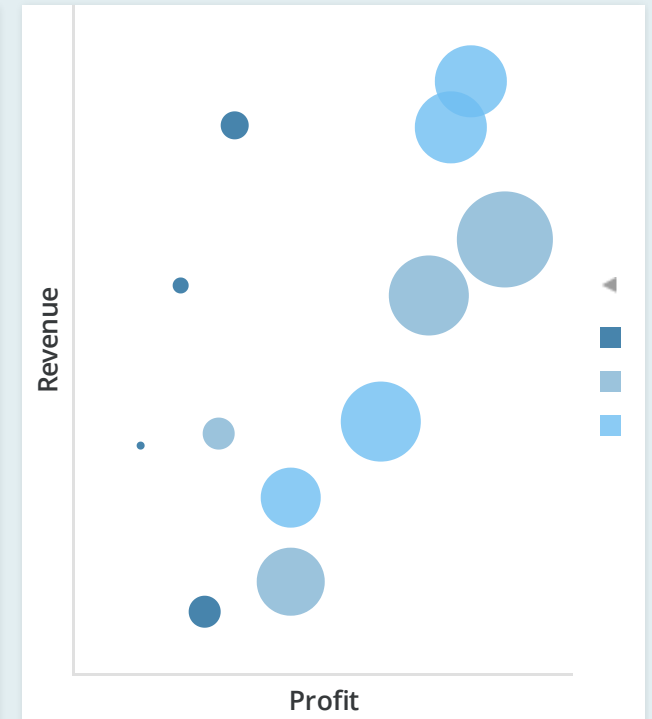
Vertical Bar Chart

Uses the height of vertical bars to compare data values across categories.



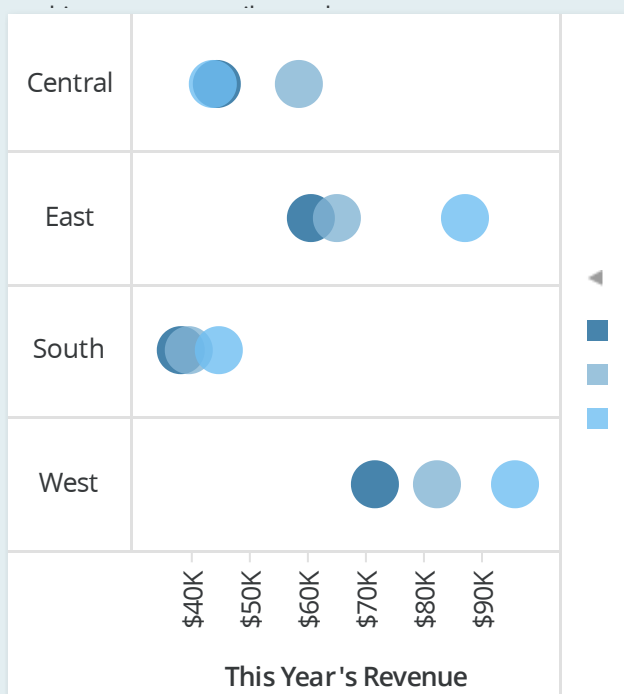
Bubble Chart

Uses position, color and size to show relationships and correlations.



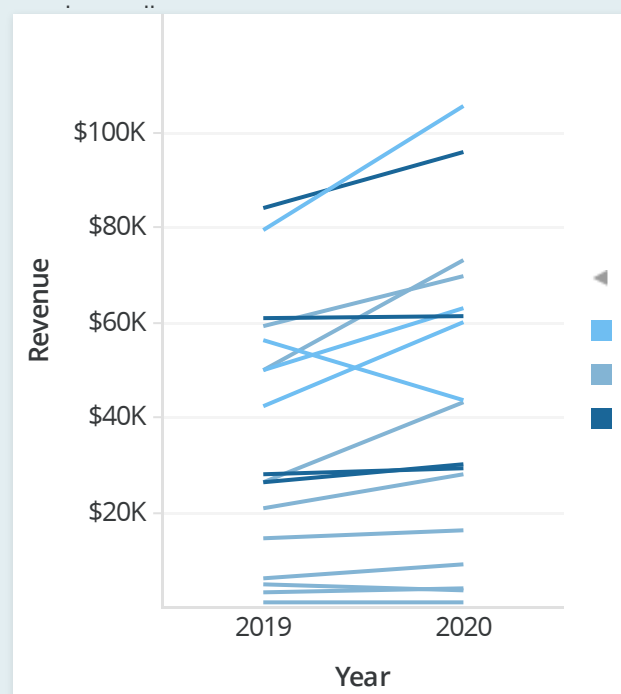
Dot Strip Plot

Bubble chart that displays how a metric value is distributed across categories. The simplicity of this visualization allows users to easily compare



Slope Chart

Line chart that shows how rank changes from one attribute element to another. It is typical to use a time attribute, but other attribute types can be



Bump Chart

Line chart that displays how rank changes over time. Use when the change in rank is more important to visualize than the change in metric value.
